

## Transfer Articulation Agreement

**Pace University: School of Computer Science and Information Systems  
Pleasantville, NY and New York, NY  
and  
Westchester Community College, Valhalla, NY**

**Effective September 2002**

Pace University and Westchester Community College hereby enter into the following agreement governing the matriculation of Westchester Community College students at Pace University. Priority in admission is granted to Westchester Community College students who complete the Applied Associate Degree in Science (A.A.S.) in Computer Information Systems (CIS) with a minimum grade point average of 2.50 in the transfer curricula. Westchester Community College students must matriculate at Pace University within two years of their graduation from Westchester Community College.

According to this agreement, Pace University will:

1. Accept Westchester Community College students as juniors provided they have achieved a minimum grade of "C" in all courses required for their major at Pace University, and have completed the courses stated in the transfer guidelines.
2. After consultation with Westchester Community College, provide transfer guidelines which indicate courses the student should complete at Westchester Community College.

According to this agreement, Westchester Community College will:

1. Publicize the agreement among its students and faculty;
2. Review the performance of the Westchester Community College students who matriculate at Pace University to assess the students' academic preparation.

According to this agreement, both institutions agree to:

1. Monitor the academic performance of students enrolling under the agreement, identifying problems, and working cooperatively to adjust course sequence and content so that students can transfer with no academic disruptions;
2. Arrange transfer meetings to update major course equivalencies between Pace University and Westchester Community College;
3. Notify each other concerning any contemplated curricular changes which would affect the future of this agreement;
4. Evaluate those students *not* completing the associate degree on a course by course basis.
